

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

Meeting of the Evansville Town Council, Evansville, Wyoming

April 22, 2019

The regular meeting of the Evansville Town Council of the Town of Evansville, County of Natrona, State of Wyoming, was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jennifer Sorenson at 7:00 p.m. and upon roll call the following were present: Mayor Jennifer Sorenson, Council Members Chad Edwards, Aaron Vigneault and Sheena Hixson, Chief of Police Mike Thompson, Fire Chief Leo Malsom, Public Works Director Ron Emond, Town Clerk Janelle Underwood, and interested citizens.

Council Member Joseph Knop and Town Engineer Shane Porter asked to be excused.

Mayor Jennifer Sorenson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion was made by Aaron Vigneault and seconded by Sheena Hixson to approve the agenda with the removal of the Engineer's Report and adding in its place the Swearing in of a New Police Officer. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes for the regular meeting on April 8, 2019, and the April 8, 2019, Work Session were presented for approval. Motion was made by Chad Edwards and seconded by Aaron Vigneault to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried.

CANCELLATION OF MAY 27, 2019 COUNCIL MEETING AND RESCHEDULE: Due to the Memorial Day Holiday, motion was made by Chad Edwards and seconded by Sheena Hixson to cancel the May 27, 2019, Council Meeting and reschedule it for Wednesday, May 29, 2019. Motion carried.

ORDINANCE #2-2019: An Ordinance Repealing Chapter 19 of the Town Code and Substituting Chapter 19 as it Appears in the Ordinance. Third and final reading. Motion was made by Aaron Vigneault and seconded by Chad Edwards to approve Ordinance #2-2019. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BUSINESS LICENSES: Approval of Business License for 307 All American Roofing, Allen's Roofing, Kenny's Mobile Home Movers, and Mesa Natural Gas Solutions were presented to the Governing Body for approval.

Mayor Sorenson asked if Chief Thompson or Town Clerk Janelle Underwood had any input concerning Kenny's Mobile Home Movers.

Chief Thompson stated that at this time he did not. He stated that the discussion has mostly been with Town Clerk Janelle Underwood. He stated that Kenny's Mobile Home Movers is planning to move trailers out of the Aspen's Mobile Home Park.

Mayor Sorenson asked if the owner of Kenny's Mobile Home Movers provided anything regarding the handling of asbestos.

Town Clerk Janelle Underwood stated that she advised Kenny's Mobile Home Movers that if he was going to be starting the process of working on the trailers that have asbestos, it would require another

license because asbestos removal would be out of the scope of work that he is presenting on this business license application. She stated that the Town would also be looking for certifications from the State of Wyoming as far as the asbestos removal.

Mayor Sorenson asked if Kenny's Mobile Home Movers was aware of providing the Town additional information and asked if he had any kind of a plan.

Town Clerk Janelle Underwood stated that he had not.

Motion was made by Aaron Vigneault and seconded by Sheena Hixson to approve the business licenses for 307 All American Roofing, Allen's Roofing, and Mesa Natural Gas Solutions. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Sheena Hixson and seconded by Aaron Vigneault to table Kenny's Mobile Home Movers to the May 13, 2019, Council Meeting. Motion carried.

APPROVAL TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH COVENANT INSURANCE GROUP:
Mayor Jennifer Sorenson stated that she would like approval to enter into an agreement with Covenant Insurance Group for insurance consulting for the Town's health insurance.

Motion was made by Aaron Vigneault and seconded Chad Edwards to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Covenant Insurance Group for insurance consulting. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF CATERING PERMITS: Town Clerk Janelle Underwood stated that Butch's Happy Days Liquor applied for two catering permits for events to be held on Saturday, June 8, 2019, for parking lot party and Tuesday, July 9, 2019, for a parking lot party in conjunction with Parade Day.

Mayor Sorenson asked Chief of Police Mike Thompson if he had any input or concerns.

Chief Thompson stated not at this time but that he will make sure he has additional police officers on duty.

Motion was made by Aaron Vigneault and seconded by Chad Edwards to approve the Catering Permits for Butch's Happy Days Liquor. Motion carried.

SWEAR IN NEW OFFICER: Chief of Police Mike Thompson introduced Brandi Wagner, newly hired Police Officer for the Town of Evansville. Town Clerk Janelle Underwood administered the Oath of Office.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: During public comments, Betty Hobbs stated that she lives on the corner of First Street and Texas Street. She stated that recently a tiny home was moved in across the street from her and wanted to know if it is acceptable. She stated that a few years ago her neighbor wanted to build park model trailers and was told that it was not acceptable. She stated that it is a cute little home but that she is concerned it will drive down the property values.

Mayor Sorenson stated that she will look into it.
