

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

Meeting of the Evansville Town Council, Evansville, Wyoming

October 28, 2019

The regular meeting of the Evansville Town Council of the Town of Evansville, County of Natrona, State of Wyoming, was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jennifer Sorenson at 7:00 p.m. and upon roll call the following were present: Council Members Aaron Vigneault, Chad Edwards, and Sheena Hixson, Town Attorney Scott Murray, Town Treasurer Lexi Erickson, Chief of Police Mike Thompson, Fire Chief Leo Malsom, Public Works Director Ron Emond, Town Clerk Janelle Underwood, and interested citizens.

Council Member Joe Knop and Town Engineer Shane Porter asked to be excused.

Mayor Jennifer Sorenson led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion was made by Aaron Vigneault and seconded by Chad Edwards to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes for the regular meeting October 14, 2019, and Executive Session for October 14, 2019, were presented for approval. Motion was made by Sheena Hixson and seconded by Chad Edwards to approve the minutes as written.

AUTHORIZATION FOR MAYOR TO EXECUTE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING/NATRONA COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT: Town Clerk Janelle Underwood advised the Governing Body that she had for their approval authorizing the Mayor to execute the Memorandum of Understanding between the Town of Evansville through its Police Department and Natrona County School District Concerning Law Enforcement Officers.

Chief of Police Mike Thompson advised the Governing Body the Memorandum of Understanding came about a year ago when he was in discussions with the school about having direct access to the school. He stated that during these discussions, it was also brought up about having a police officer spend a certain amount of hours in the school during class time and that the Natrona County School District would pay the Town of Evansville about seven thousand seven hundred dollars (\$7,700.00) for the officers' time spent in the school during the school year. He stated that the time spent by the Evansville Police Department does not include the time that is spent for traffic control before and after school. He stated that the time frame that the officer spends at the school will vary from day to day.

Motion was made by Sheena Hixson and seconded by Aaron Vigneault authorizing the Mayor to execute the Memorandum of Understanding between the Town of Evansville through its Police Department and Natrona County School District Concerning Law Enforcement Officers. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BUSINESS LICENSES: Approval of Business Licenses for Brenton Management & Supply, Energy 1, LLC, GA Sleep, Inc., and Precision Plumbing were presented to the Governing Body for approval. Motion was made by Aaron Vigneault and seconded by Chad Edwards to approve the business license for Brenton Management & Supply, Energy 1, LLC, GA Sleep, Inc., and Precision Plumbing. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: There were no public comments.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business, motion was made by Sheena Hixson and seconded by Chad Edwards to adjourn at 7:07 p.m. Motion carried.
