

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

Meeting of the Evansville Town Council, Evansville, Wyoming

August 8, 2022

The regular meeting of the Evansville Town Council of the Town of Evansville, County of Natrona, State of Wyoming, was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem Joe Knop at 7:00 p.m. and upon roll call the following were present: Council Members Candace Machado, Michael Scott, and Dacia Edwards, Town Attorney Alia Scott, Town Treasurer Lexi Erickson, Chief of Police Mike Thompson, Fire Chief Leo Malsom, Public Works Director Robert Lewallen, Town Clerk Janelle Underwood, and interested citizens.

Mayor Chad Edwards asked to be excused.

Mayor Pro Tem Joe Knop led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion was made by Michael Scott and seconded by Dacia Edwards to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA:

- A) Approval of Minutes for Regular Meeting July 25, 2022
- B) Approval of Business License – Recycled Materials, LLC
- C) Approval of Bills

Motion was made by Michael Scott and seconded by Candace Machado to approve the Consent Agenda. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF MEDICAL DIRECTOR AGREEMENT: Town Clerk Janelle Underwood advised that she needed authorization for the Mayor to execute the Emergency Medical Director Physician Services Agreement. She stated that the agreement had been reviewed by Town Attorney Alia Scott and Fire Chief Leo Malsom and that the proposed agreement has changed from renewing annually to every three years. She advised that this is for the medical director that oversees the Evansville Emergency Services.

Motion was made by Michael Scott and seconded by Dacia Edwards authorizing the Mayor to execute the Emergency Medical Director Physicians Services Agreement. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: During public comments, Phil Gierke stated that he would like to thank who ever cut down the weeds on Curtis Street by the railroad tracks. He also stated that he has a couple of trailers that have been parked on the street for more than seven days, and that one of them is a boat and trailer that is parked the wrong direction.

Mr. Gierke said that he, along with several other people in town are having problems with the Post Office and people's mail not getting delivered to the right address. He stated that he thought it would be great if somebody from the Town would talk to the Post Office about the issues that residents are having with the mail delivery. He also mentioned about the potholes getting bad again at the bank of mailboxes off Platte Park Road.

Council Member Candace Machado said that she can relate to the issues the residents are having with the Post Office because she was in contact with the Post Office about two months ago over the same issue.

Town Clerk Janelle Underwood stated that the Town has had the same issues with the mail. The Town also has issues with mail being marked undeliverable and that someone from the Town has spoken to the Post Office about it.
