Work Session

A Work Session was held on August 15, 2022, at 6:38 p.m. Present were Mayor Chad Edwards, Council Members Candace Machado, Michael Scott, and Dacia Edwards. Also present were Chief of Police Mike Thompson and Town Clerk Janelle Underwood.

Discussion on the Parking of Trailers on Town Streets: The purpose of the Work Session was to discuss a possible ordinance change regarding the parking of trailers on the Town streets. Mayor Edwards said that he spoke with Police Chief Mike Thompson and asked him to look at similar communities to see what would work for his department since they are the ones who will be enforcing the ordinance.

Chief Thompson said that after hearing the comments at the Council Meeting and reading the emails and letters that the Town received, he stated that he did some research as to what similar communities had adopted. He presented to the Governing Body some possible language that could be used in a new ordinance. He stated that he is trying to find a middle ground to meet the needs of those who want the trailer parking ordinance to go away completely and for those who do not believe people should be able to leave trailers parked on the streets.

The Governing Body went through the proposal that Chief Thompson put together and a draft ordinance will be presented to the Governing Body at the August 22, 2022, Council Meeting.

The Work Session was adjourned at 8:45 p.m. No action taken.
