

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

Meeting of the Evansville Town Council, Evansville, Wyoming

May 8, 2023

The regular meeting of the Evansville Town Council of the Town of Evansville, County of Natrona, State of Wyoming, was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Chad Edwards at 7:00 p.m. and upon roll call the following were present: Council Members Dacia Edwards, and Greg Flesvig, Town Attorney Scott Murray, Town Treasurer Lexi Erickson, Public Works Director Robert Lewallen, Town Clerk Janelle Underwood, and interested citizens.

Council Member Candace Machado, Council Member Michael Scott, Chief of Police Mike Thompson, and Fire Chief Leo Malsom asked to be excused.

Mayor Edwards led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion was made by Greg Flesvig and seconded by Dacia Edwards to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

ORDINANCE #3-2023: An Ordinance Granting an Electric Utility Franchise and General Utility Easement to Rocky Mountain Power. Third and final reading. Town Clerk Janelle Underwood read Ordinance #3-2023 by title only.

Motion was made by Greg Flesvig and seconded by Dacia Edwards to approve Ordinance #3-2023 on third and final reading. Motion carried.

DAVID HULSHIZER – YOUTH CRISIS CENTER: David Hulshizer with the Youth Crisis Center spoke to the Governing Body and thanked them for taking the time to consider the budgetary request of funding for the Youth Crisis Center and the at-risk youth. He stated that the struggle is real when it comes to funding and that they are having to turn to the local communities for funding. He asked if the Town of Evansville would consider a Budgetary Request of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) and provided statistics from the tracking that had been completed in the last nine months.
