

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

Meeting of the Evansville Town Council, Evansville, Wyoming

May 22, 2023

The regular meeting of the Evansville Town Council of the Town of Evansville, County of Natrona, State of Wyoming, was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Chad Edwards at 7:00 p.m. and upon roll call the following were present: Council Members Candace Machado, and Dacia Edwards, Town Attorney Scott Murray, Chief of Police Mike Thompson, Fire Chief Leo Malsom, Public Works Director Robert Lewallen, Town Clerk Janelle Underwood, and interested citizens.

Mayor Chad Edwards led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion was made by Dacia Edwards and seconded by Candace Machado to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA:

- a) Approval of Minutes for Regular Meeting May 8, 2023, and the May 17, 2023, Work Session
- b) Approval of Business Licenses – Integrity Electric, Sky Construction, Skyline Construction and TechPoint

Motion was made by Dacia Edwards and seconded by Candace Machado to approve the Consent Agenda. Motion carried.

RATIFY MAYOR'S SIGNATURE – CEDAR SPRINGS WIND IV IMPACT ASSISTANCE FUNDS MEMORANFUM OF UNDERSTANDING: Town Clerk Janelle Underwood read by title the Memorandum of Understanding for the Cedar Springs Wind IV Impact Assistance Funds. She advised that the funds are to offset the impacts from the windfarm project and asked for a motion to ratify the Mayor's signature of the Memorandum of Understanding.

Motion was made by Candace Machado and seconded by Dacia Edwards ratifying the Mayor's signature on the Cedar Springs Wind IV Impact Assistance Memorandum of Understanding. Motion carried.

ORDINANCE #4-2023: An Ordinance Amending the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year Budget. First reading. Town Clerk Janelle Underwood read Ordinance #4-2023.

Motion was made by Candace Machado and seconded by Dacia Edwards to approve Ordinance #4-2023 on first reading. Motion carried.

ORDINANCE #5-2023: An Ordinance Approving the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year Budget. First reading. Town Clerk Janelle Underwood read Ordinance #5-2023.

Motion was made by Candace Machado and seconded by Dacia Edwards to approve Ordinance #5-2023 on first reading. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: During public comments, a resident spoke to the Governing Body about the speed limit on Memorial Way, especially now that it is paved. She stated that the roads that lead to it are posted thirty miles per hour and forty miles per hour.

Mayor Edwards stated that it has been brought up and that he and Chief Thompson have had discussions on it, but wanted to get the road opened back up and get people driving on it again before any decisions are made.

Chief Thompson stated that the City of Casper owns half the road, so he needs to reach out to them to discuss. He stated that once the road reopens, they will start watching the traffic and have those discussions.

Councilmember Candace Machado stated that the new Community Garden will be located along Copper Avenue between Fifth Street and Sixth Street. She stated that the Public Works Department has been working hard and

has done a wonderful job on it. She stated they should start planting in the next week or so and wishes to invite the community out to help with the gardening.

Councilmember Candace Machado also stated that Evansville will be holding its 100 Year Celebration on June 24, 2023, from 2:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at Reshaw Park. She stated that the committee has been working hard to put this together and that there will be vendors, food trucks and bands and the community is invited to come and celebrate.


Mayor Edwards stated he stopped by the Community Garden, and Public Works has done a great job. He stated that it is truly a community garden and encourages the residents to come out and help throughout the summer and at the end of the summer there should be a lot to harvest.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business, motion was made by Dacia Edwards and seconded by Candace Machado to adjourn at 7:15 p.m. Motion carried.
