

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

Meeting of the Evansville Town Council, Evansville, Wyoming

April 11, 2016

The regular meeting of the Evansville Town Council of the Town of Evansville, County of Natrona, State of Wyoming, was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Phil Hinds at 7:00 p.m. and upon roll call the following were present: Mayor Phil Hinds, Council Members Doug White, Ernie Blackford, Joseph Knop and Jory Delinger, Town Attorney Phil Willoughby, Town Planner Scott Radden, Town Treasurer Peggy Nading, Chief of Police Tom Laughrey, Fire Chief Leo Malsom, Public Works Director Dan Adcock, Town Clerk Janelle Underwood, and interested citizens.

Town Engineer Shane Porter asked to be excused.

Mayor Phil Hinds led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion was made by Ernie Blackford and seconded by Joseph Knop to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes for the regular meeting on March 28, 2016, were presented for approval. Motion was made by Joseph Knop and seconded by Ernie Blackford to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF DEPARTMENTAL MONTHLY REPORT: The Treasurer's report, Police report, Fire report, and the Public Works report were presented to the Governing Body in writing. Motion was made by Doug White and seconded by Joseph Knop to approve the departmental monthly reports. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BUSINESS LICENSE: Business License application for Fantabulous Nails was presented for approval. Motion was made by Ernie Blackford and seconded by Doug White to approve the business license for Fantabulous Nails. Motion carried.

CASPER LODGE 30 DAY BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWAL: Fire Chief Leo Malsom advised the Governing Body that the monthly inspection of the Casper Lodge was conducted last week. He advised that a lot of work has been taking place. He advised that last month a separate inspection took place in the area where Wyoming Downs is located within the Casper Lodge. He stated electrical issues were found that needed to be addressed and that all of those issues were corrected within thirty (30) days. He stated that as far as the motel side of the inspection, all of the metal piping that has to be installed for the dry system is about half way completed and that they are also in the process of installing soffit to cover the fire suppression water lines. He stated that it looks like the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality is going to issue the permit for the fire suppression system. He stated that he recommended that the Casper Lodge be granted another 30 day license renewal.

Motion was made by Doug White and seconded by Ernie Blackford to approve the business license for 30 days for the Casper Lodge. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BUILDING PERMITS: Building Permit applications #4235 through #4238 were presented to the Governing Body for approval. The applications were for fences, a shed, and a re-roof. Motion was made by Ernie Blackford and seconded by Joseph Knop to approve permits #4235 through #4238. Motion carried.

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BILLS FOR APPROVAL: Bills were presented to the Governing Body for approval. Motion was made by Jory Delinger and seconded by Doug White to pay all bills and draw treasury upon the same. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: There were no public comments.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business, motion was made by Jory Delinger and seconded by Joseph Knop to adjourn at 7:07 p.m. Motion carried.
