

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

Meeting of the Evansville Town Council, Evansville, Wyoming

April 27, 2015

The regular meeting of the Evansville Town Council of the Town of Evansville, County of Natrona, State of Wyoming, was held at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Phil Hinds at 7:00 p.m. and upon roll call the following were present: Mayor Phil Hinds, Council Members Doug White, Ernie Blackford, Joe Knop, and Jory Delinger, Town Engineer Shane Porter, Town Planner Scott Radden, Town Treasurer Peggy Nading, Chief of Police Tom Laughrey, Fire Chief Leo Malsom, Public Works Director Dan Adcock, Town Clerk Janelle Underwood, and interested citizens.

Town Attorney Phil Willoughby asked to be excused.

Mayor Hinds led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion was made by Ernie Blackford and seconded by Joe Knop to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The minutes for the regular meeting on April 13, 2015, and the minutes for the April 15, 2015, and April 16, 2015, workshops were presented for approval. Motion was made by Doug White and seconded by Joe Knop to approve the minutes as written. Motion carried.

CANCELLATION OF MAY 25, 2015. COUNCIL MEETING AND RE-SCHEDULE: Town Clerk Janelle Underwood advised the Mayor and Town Council that the regular scheduled Council Meeting for May 25, 2015, is the Memorial Day Holiday. She advised that she would like approval to cancel the meeting and re-schedule it for Tuesday, May 26, 2015, at its regular time.

Motion was made by Doug White and seconded by Ernie Blackford to cancel the May 25, 2015, Council Meeting and re-schedule it for May 26, 2015. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION #10-2015: A Resolution Recognizing Lot 84, Reshaw Addition as a Non-Conforming Lot Size within the R-1 Zoning, Town Of Evansville, Wyoming. Town Clerk Janelle Underwood summarized Resolution #10-2015. Motion was made by Ernie Blackford and seconded by Doug White to approve Resolution #10-2015. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BUSINESS LICENSES: Business License applications for Precision Builders, Inc., and Wyoming Grass Choppers were presented to the Governing Body for approval. Motion was made by Doug White and seconded by Joe Knop to approve the business license applications for Precision Builders, Inc., and Wyoming Grass Choppers. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF BUILDING PERMIT: Building Permit Applications #4150 through #4157 were presented to the Governing Body for approval. The applications were for a new construction, re-roof, and fences. Motion was made by Doug White and seconded by Ernie Blackford to approve permits #4150 through #4157.

ENGINEER'S REPORT: No report.

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PUBLIC COMMENTS: During public comments, a group of students spoke to the Governing Body about their participation in Destination Imagination which is a volunteer-led non-profit organization. They stated that the purpose of their group is to inspire and equip students to become the next generation of leaders. They stated that on April 2, 2015, their group put together a community awareness event and that the topic was suicide prevention and awareness. They stated that the event was a great success and that they won first place in the state competition. They stated that because of the first place winning, they have been invited to the Global Competition in Knoxville, Tennessee, on May 19, 2015, and stated that they are seeking monetary donations to fund the expenses for this upcoming event. They stated that they anticipate that they will need around ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) and that they have raised approximately five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) so far.

Mayor Hinds thanked the students and advised that the Town will take it under advisement.
